Dear Patrick,

As early as Monday the Republicans in the Indiana House will try a rare procedural move called a "blast motion" to force the Speaker of the House to bring Senate Joint Resolution 7 to the floor for a vote.

SJR 7 seeks to start the process to amend the Indiana Constitution to protect Indiana laws defining marriage as one man and one woman.

CONTACT YOUR HOUSE MEMBER IN SUPPORT OF SJR7.

Indiana is currently being sued by the Indiana Civil Liberties Union in an attempt to allow same-sex marriage in the state.

Indiana Attorney General Steve Carter has asked the legislature to pass SJR 7, calling it necessary to preserve Indiana's marriage laws.

All 49 Republicans support the blast motion, but it needs 51 votes for it to succeed. At least two Democrats need to take a strong stand for marriage next week.

Contact your House member and urge their support of this resolution.

As California and Massachusetts are battling over marriage, (they had state laws too, but no amendment!) your voice is needed now more than ever!
